Currently CWS works with 71 Partner NGOs, 9 Networks and 12 Fellows supported in different kinds of outreach work that fit into the CWS programmatic focus in the six states of Bihar, Jharkhand, Orissa, Andhra Pradesh (AP), Telangana and Tamil Nadu. Centre for World Solidarity works with three thematic issues; Human Dignity, Sustainable Livelihoods and People Centred Governance in six states. Under Human Dignity theme we work for the empowerment of Women, Dalits, Adivasis and Minorities.

CWS is looking for recruiting self-driven committed persons for this position for it Jharkhand office, based at Jamshedpur. The selected incumbent should work with Women, children and Men of all communities especially the Adivasi communities of Ghatshila block of East Singhbhum district, Jharkhand state.

The persons should have comprehensive knowledge and work experience on issues of marginalized communities, **on WASH, Food and Nutrition and in Agriculture.** They should extend handholding support to the community leaders who are addressing these issues at village level.

Major Responsibilities for Program Officer

1. Will provide required technical expertise in their respective streams and ensure convergence of nutrition, agriculture and WASH interventions on the ground.
2. The Subject Matter Specialists will work in close collaboration with the government technical experts in the block/district/state and ensure a good cooperation between these departments in the project area
3. Provide support to target communities on relevant issues and be responsible for knowledge building of the concerned communities

4. Undertake regular field visits at least 15 days in a month to appraise, monitor, review and organize capacity building activities etc with partners
5. Plan and bring out IEC material for awareness, training, campaign etc from time to time as part of capacity building of partners.
6. Generate necessary time bound reports, document programs.
7. Plan for trainings, campaigns etc from time to time as part of capacity building of partners.
8. Interact and build linkages with resource agencies, appropriate organizations, other stakeholders for networking
9. Represent CWS at all appropriate forums and institutions.
10. Monitor/Evaluate events at districts as well as state whenever necessary
11. Identify policy level issues from field & develop strategies to address them.
12. Any other responsibility assigned by line manager

Essential Qualifications and experience

For Program Officer - Post Graduate in social sciences or other relevant streams, M.S.W, MA RD, Nutrition, WASH, Agriculture and comparable qualification with three years experience in direct field level implementation in the concerned subject areas. Women candidates are especially encouraged to apply.
