# SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS

- In all 14946 farmers adopted sustainable agriculture this year.
- 375 SHGs in Andhra Pradesh availed loans (ranging from Rs.50,000/- to Rs.1,50,000/- to each SHG) for income generation activities like petty shops, purchase of sheep, vegetable vending, cloth business, agricultural inputs, etc. As a result, the income levels of SHG members improved from Rs.1000/- to Rs.1500/- per month.
- More than 100 dalit families benefited by Rs 6,500/- per acre after opting for millet cultivation, and were able to increase their income by Rs 300/- per month, besides having nutritious organic vegetables from their kitchen gardens.
- Mangroves conservation helped fishermen to earn Rs 5000/- to 7000/- in five villages.



# SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS

- 360 farmers earned additional income of Rs 1000/- per month by adopting SRI methods.
- Through convergence and linkage with different government agencies, Rs 1.15 crores was mobilised for micro irrigation support to the farmers.
- Training and support to 180 women on value addition of NTFP, on Adda leaf plate making and tamarind deseeding and packing helped improve average monthly incomes by Rs.1000/- to Rs.1500/- per month.
- 272 families diverted from beedi making to activities like tailoring, petty shop, sari business, agarbathi making, through training and other support. The diversified economic activities have provided an additional monthly income ranging between Rs.3000/- to Rs.4,500/-.



# SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS

- In Bihar, 1790 acres of water logged area was reclaimed by constructing five drainage channels this year and in the previous phase 1332.51 acres of water logged area was reclaimed by constructing three drainage channels. This helped to increase cropping intensity by three times.
- Livestock promotion among landless poor especially Dalits helped to improve their incomes by Rs. 2000/ month, through goat rearing, poultry and pig rearing.
- Approval and sanction of Rupees One crore, based on the micro-plan, for construction of an embankment to a Panchayat by the State Government proves the success of the initiative. Similarly, several works like, plantation, road construction, embankment, construction of houses under IAY, and irrigation facilities; were undertaken in targeted Panchayats.



# SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOODS

- In Jharkhand, 338 farmers have adopted SRI and SWI methods and enhanced their monthly income by Rs 500/-.
- 558 farmers were involved in lac production yielding very good income to the farmers.
- In Odisha, 850 small and marginal farmers have adopted sustainable agricultural practices and improved their livelihood.
- Advocacy efforts in Odisha helped to open new phadi's (weekly market) and are showing results. A new phadi for purchasing kendu leaf has been opened benefiting women farmers.
- In Tamil Nadu, 60 farmers (Widows and destitute women) have followed sustainable agricultural practices cultivating millets in 60 acres of land and have benefited.



# PEOPLE CENTRED GOVERNANCE

- 1572 elected representatives to the institutions of local governance were capacitated on their roles and responsibilities.
- In Andhra Pradesh, Micro-plans of 35 Gram Panchayats (GP) were revisited and fine-tuned. 4677 people participated in the development of micro-plans. 40 Functional committees have been strengthened and were facilitated to implement micro-plans, address local issues and ensure effective implementation of government schemes. 117 Gram Sabhas were conducted with a participation of 12597 participants.
- Three GPs selected under Bharath Nirman Abhiyan (BNA), a scheme to promote village sanitation and hygiene, were sanctioned with construction of 936 toilets.

# PEOPLE CENTRED GOVERNANCE

- Local Panchayat representatives could mobilise Krushi Vignan Kendra (KVK) and National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) through Indira Kranti Patham (IKP) to support SRI activity, taken up by 120 farmers in 120 acres, leading to increased incomes by Rs.10,000/- per annum/ per acre.
- In Odisha, Village development plans developed for 31 villages and endorsed at Panchayat level. Implementation rate is more than 50% of the proposed activities. Four Panchayat Level Task Force Committees are formed and capacitated on various government schemes.
- Women Elected Representatives Forums are fully active addressing women related issues— women's health, education, pension and women's participation in Gram Sabha and Palli Sabha and livelihood entitlement.



# PEOPLE CENTRED GOVERNANCE

- In Bihar, women PRI members have formed a forum called Mahila Jagriti Manch. In addition, four PRI Women Forums and two Block level PRI Forums were constituted to address issues related to drinking water, disbursement of residential certificates, allotment and utilisation of BRGF funds, allotment of funds for pension, NREGA, issues of sanitation, land and livelihood, social security and entitlement issues. The Forums prepared plans for improving productivity of the forest lands allotted to forest dwellers under FRA.
- In Jharkhand, interventions in 50 villages of 8 Panchayats reached out to 34403 persons. Efforts are aimed to ensure development of 3 Model Panchayats for replication in future.
