

**WORKSHOP ON
OUTCOME IMPACT ORIENTED PROJECT PLANNING AND MONITORING
&
OUTCOME IMPACT ORIENTED MIS DATA STRUCTURING**

In the recent past, almost all the development institutions has shifted their focus on the outcome and impact that can be achieved through the project intervention rather than just smooth implementation of project activities. At the same time it becomes responsibility of the implementing organisations to demonstrate their project`s contribution in realising towards development goals as well as their capacity to provide evidence on the impact accomplished with factual yard sticks.

Keeping this as threshold for future project`s outcome; TNRC along with partners of Tamilnadu has organised two days workshop on understanding the concepts of Outcome Impact Oriented project planning and monitoring, and accordingly developing measurable indicators for their stated objectives of the project using OIO tool.

In continuation to this workshop, the partners has organised yet another two day workshop on developing data for MIS structuring, through their own contributions. This workshop has developed data required to measure the change in the projects implemented under Human Dignity and Livelihood themes. TNRC along with its partners will soon share the format for capturing data to design the upcoming comprehensive MIS for CWS.
